Depending on our circumstances we have all had to put our efforts into helping those affected by the crisis.

In his Easter message, Pope Francis calls on everyone to "give a further proof of solidarity, even if we have to follow new paths to do so". He emphasises a "concretely tangible spirit of solidarity, especially in today's circumstances, that rivalries do not resurface, but that all recognize each other as part of one family and support each other. At the next study days, 30th June to 5th July 2021 in Riga we want to exchange views on what our associations are contributing to the renewal of the Catholic Church, and this will continue the theme of our study days in Snagov/Romania in 2019.

During this time we should have met in Baden-Baden. Unfortunately this was not possible due to the Corona virus regulations. This crisis will challenge all of us personally and economically for a long time to come, and certainly this will also have an influence on the work in our associations.

The CoCoA members are very busy with Corona-related actions: work from home, cancellation and reorganization of meetings, food banks, support of family, relatives and people at risk, neighbourhood help, video conferences, and online teaching etc.

As an Andante member organisation or as a participant of ANDANTE Study Days, we would be pleased if you would share with us any of your experiences, activities and ideas during this corona virus pandemic, which is unprecedented for all of us, and enter into a mutual, sisterly exchange with members. We hope to share this exchange of experiences in our next letter and next meeting.

We are all invited to pray at this time that the Holy Spirit will enlighten and strengthen us all, so we can take the necessary steps to make a better world.
